New Business/ LE News

- As everyone can see we have now decided to offer the option to attend our meetings virtually using the Zoom App. We figured this would help us share more info with the members who are unable to attend for various reasons. We plan to save the recordings of the meetings on our website.
- Our hearts go out to the families of Lt. Michael Hoosack and Officer Michael Jensen who were Killed in the line of duty on April 14th after responding to a suspicious vehicle call. Hoosack, 37 years old, had around 16 years with the Onondaga Sheriffs Dept. and was married with 3 kids ages 3, 5 and 7. Jensen, 29 years old, became the first line of duty death in Syracuse PD since 1990. Jensen worked as an accountant prior to joining the Syracuse PD less than 3 years ago. We sent the link for the opportunity to purchase memorial bracelets from Etsy. Proceeds will be going to the families.
- We also lost Sgt. Chris Beach from Greece PD on April 23rd after a courageous battle with Leukemia.
- Senator Gillibrand is introducing a bill into the Senate under section 3884 to establish a grant pilot program for the minor children of LE officers to accommodate the shift work and abnormal work hours to enhance recruitment and retention. The period of the grant would be for 3 years. For agencies that employ less than 200 full-time officers.
- I am going to give you some inside information regarding the automated work zone speed Enforcement tickets. If you get a ticket, dispute it. You can dispute it based on arguing there is No time stamp on the pictures therefore there is no proof that this was occurring during specified hours that construction would be taking place. IN another case, the ticket was dismissed after it was determined the picture of the violation did not show any workers in the actual work zone.
